

Pasifika in the TEU

Representation on TEU Council

In July 2018 the TEU Tangata Pasifika Advisory Group, met with the Te Toi Ahurangi (Māori Caucus) to establish a relationship between the two caucuses. During the meeting Te Toi Ahurangi and the Tiriti Partnership Group committed to support TPAG to:

- 1. find their place on the side of the crown with Pākehā and non-Māori;
- 2. develop their Tiriti relationship moving forward;
- 3. maintain an ongoing relationship with Te Toi Ahurangi and TRG e.g. annual or biennial meeting kanohi ki te kanohi; and
- 4. draft a rule remit to create a Pasifika position on TEU Council.

During the TEU National Council in March 2019, Bill Rogers, Co-Chair of the Te Tiriti Relationship Group, tabled the above recommendation and the below remit was discussed and agreed in principle. The remit was passed by our May conference to elect a Pasifika representative to the Council.







Call for nominations

Nominations are called for the following positions for the remainder of the 2019/2020 term

Council: One Pasifika staff representative

The term of the positions will be from date of election until 31 December 2020.

Candidates for these positions, their nominator, and seconder must all be financial members and belong to the relevant constituency. For example, to be nominated for a position on the Council as the Pasifika staff

representative position, the person nominated, the nominator and the seconder must all be Pasifika.
